



## Head Cook

### Responsibilities

- Shall develop kid-friendly menus 3-4 weeks prior to the beginning of the camping season (06/22/14) and place the supply order with Grand Valley Foods.
- If necessary, shall contact the Business Manager or Members of the Program Committee to procure emergency and last minute food items.
- Shall prepare meals at times set by the camp deans. Typically meals occur at 8:00 am, 12:00 pm and 5:30 pm but some days have adjusted schedules as determined by the deans.
- Shall oversee the assistant cook(s).
- Shall model a servant's heart, a love for kids and Christian behavior while representing the camp.
- Shall refrain from the use of alcohol, marijuana, tobacco, and illicit drugs while on the GMCA grounds.

### Requirements

- Experience cooking for large groups (50-150) is preferred.
- Must be capable of working at high elevations.
- Must be available for the entire Baptist camping season (6/22/14 – 07/12/14)

### Compensation and Benefits

- \$1,800 for the entire three week camping season
- Room and Board in the cook's cabin
- May request individuals for the camp to hire as assistant cook(s).
- Days off during the camping season 2014 include:
  - After brunch Friday 06/27 to the afternoon of Sunday 06/29.
  - After brunch Saturday 07/05 to the afternoon of Sunday 07/06.
